The Jake Bartley Band: The Jake Bartley Band, which formed in Greenwood, features an array of experienced musicians and songwriters who, individually, have performed on the Today Show and the Rachel Ray Show, at the Grand Ole Opry, and at numerous other venues and festivals. The band is led by singer Jake Bartley, and features Andrew Crawford and Matt Miller on bass, guitar and vocals, and Adam Plott on percussion. The band has also added Bill Christmas to play saxophone, creating a fuller sound overall. The Jake Bartley Band's style is a fusion of soul, rock, blues, folk and funk. After years of performing and promoting themselves at a local level, 3 and Twenty has worked their way up to touring regionally and nationally, and has had the opportunity to enhance their songwriting ability with some of the best songwriters in Nashville. While their music could be most simply classified as country, 3 and Twenty mix in pop, R&B, Southern Rock and Hip Hop.
